The Psychosocial Risk Assessment Inventory involves a series of tools that assess primary stressors in the work environment and personal wellbeing. The Psychosocial Risk Assessment is developed in accordance with the standards of ISO 46003:2021 and constitutes part of the Wellbeing Guidance Program. The scope of the assessment is to identify and analyze workplace risk factors that could potentially harm the psychological health and safety of the seafarers/employees, if not properly managed.


The psychosocial risk assessment evaluates workplace stressors that includes: Workload Balance, Job Control, Management Support, Peer Support, Work Relationships, Job Role, Workplace Changes, Organizational Support, Job Engagement, Job Development, Financial Security, Psychological Safe Interactions, Civility & Respect, Physical Environment Satisfaction, Protective Equipment Satisfaction, Organizational Culture Satisfaction, Burnout and Personal Wellbeing.


The report is color coded for easy reading and understanding. The red code indicates High Risk for workplace risk factor being evaluated indicating that urgent action is required, the yellow code indicates Moderate Risk indicating that areas for improvement is needed, the blue color indicates Low or Minimal Risk and the green code indicates No Risk relevant to workplace risk factors being evaluated.

Important Notes: Please be aware that workplace factors that represent No Risk or Low Risk may include low scoring statements indicating Moderate or High Risk. It is recommended that the scores be interpreted in context and review suggestions under the Next Steps Section of the report. The following factors: Workload Balance, Relationships, Psychological Safe Interactions contain statements that measure negative aspects of the workplace. To ensure consistency and normalize the overall scores, responses to these statements have been inversely scored. It is recommended that the results of the Psychosocial Risk Assessment be evaluated using data from a number of sources, including other surveys, sickness absence data, staff turnover rates, other information sources to help you identify hot spots and priority areas.




